Background

After 6 years of re-development, Brighton Dome Corn Exchange reopened to the public this Summer. From November onwards, we plan to showcase this beautiful building and its history to the public and are recruiting room guide volunteers to ensure that visitors are welcomed and provided with a knowledgeable and friendly experience.

What will you be doing?

The re-opening of the Corn Exchange at the start of November 2023 will allow members of the public to experience our incredible regency buildings outside of events, without a ticket!

You will be providing short tours and talks about the history of the Corn Exchange; this could incorporate a special interest of your own, such as architecture, women's suffrage, musical history, and regency history. We will be developing guides and talking point materials as a group so that you have information that you can refer to whilst volunteering.

Duties:

- Being a friendly and welcoming presence
- Sharing knowledge with the public in a kind, approachable, and interesting manner
- Directing the public around the building with opportunities to provide short tours and 'ten-minute talks'
- Carrying out checks to ensure the venue is presentable, tidy, and free from hazards (supported by Duty Manger on shift to fix any issues)
- During times where the building is quiet, use a laptop to carry out further research
- Support customers with access needs to access the venue and have an enjoyable experience
- Responding to emergencies, and helping guide visitors safely from the building in the event of an evacuation
- Reporting any security concerns to a duty manager
